August 7th, 2011 Meeting Review by John Waller

At 12:45 PM **Alan Raul** conducted his Q & A session.

At 2 PM **Sonya** from Proxure gave her demonstration of the online backup application: [Keep Vault](#).

Our main presentation was by Sonya of Proxure, Inc. They offer a backup service that stores your files in the cloud. This allows you to access them from any computer and any place. This service would be aimed at your datafiles rather than imaging files for system backup. Your account can start as small as 40 gb, and go up to 5000 gb. As a rule of thumb the price is approximately \$1 per year, per GB. I.e., 40gb ~ \$46, 1500gb ~ \$1300. While most people would not need such high capacities as they offer, if you are a photographer it can be quite useful. Obviously, the upload speed would be a restriction. Overall, they seem to offer a pretty good program if you need serious online backup.
