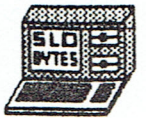

FUTURE REVIEWS

We have asked Rose and Bob to review two new programs for a future meeting (probably in June), PC-DBMStm by Kware and AVAtm.

PC-DBMStm Data Base Management System will hold an undetermined number of tables each of which may have up to 32,767 records (including deleted records) and each record may have to 999 fields.

AVAtm is the "complete Portfolio Management Program". AVA (Asset Valuation Analysis) may be readily comparable with Pfroitm that Bob Ward reviewed at our April meeting.
