### My Favorite Shortcuts:

**With Mouse/Trackball** ~ Hold down **Ctrl** and roll **Scroll Wheel** Up or Down equals Zoom or Shrink

Windows Key plus - equals Zoom In

Windows Key plus + equals Zoom Out

Hold Shift plus Enter inserts 1 line

Hold Ctrl plus Enter equals Line Go to New Page

Ctrl plus z equals Undo

Ctrl plus y equals Redo

Ctrl plus a equals Select All

Ctrl plus c equals Copy

Ctrl plus v equals Paste contents of Clipboard

PrntSC copies screen to Clipboard

Ctrl plus f equals Find on Page

**Ctrl plus Alt plus Del brings up Task Manager**

**Alt** plus **Tab** equals Show all open apps closes when released

**Windows Key** plus **Tab** equals Show all open apps and stays on screen

**Ctrl** plus **Shift** plus **ESC** equals Try to restart frozen screen

For MAC, replace **Ctrl** with **Cmd**
